RESOLUTION TO RESCIND A ~~MOTION~~ AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF A SIX INCH SEWER LINE ALONG SOUTH ELEVENTH STREET TO THE ALLEY BETWEEN SOUTH ELEVENTH STREET AND SOUTH ^{10th} STREET AND RUNNING THROUGH THE BLOCK BETWEEN SYCAMORE AND CHESTNUT STREETS AND THENCE NORTH THROUGH SAID ALLEY, THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, AND AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF SAID SEWER LINE AS DESCRIBED IN THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Taylor Co., Texas in regular session, the Mayor being present, passed a ~~Motion~~ authorizing the placing of a six inch sewer line along South Eleventh Street from a beginning point in an alley intersecting said South Eleventh Street west of Sycamore Street and thence to the alley intersecting South Eleventh Street between Sycamore Street and Chestnut Street, The City of Abilene, Texas and thence north in said alley a distance of approximately 400 feet;

And Whereas, the laying of a sewer line as above described has proven to be less feasible than a sewer line hereinafter described as beginning at the intersection of South 12th Street and Chestnut Streets, The City of Abilene, Texas: Thence North along the east boundary line of Chestnut Street to the S.B. Line of South 11th Street: Thence west along the S.B. Line of South 11th Street to the alley between Sycamore Street and Chestnut Street and between South Eleventh Street and South Tenth Street: Thence North up said alley to a distance of approximately 400 feet:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, that the motion heretofore made authorizing the laying of a six inch sewer line as first above described be and the same is hereby rescinded; and it is hereby resolved by the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Taylor Co., Texas that the said six inch sewer line be placed along and over the property as described in the second paragraph hereof. Passed this the 29th day of October 1927.
