RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCEMENT OF SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS PER CUBIC YARD FOR RIP RAP TO WOMACK CONSTRUCTION COMPANY TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT PRICE OF TWO DOLLARS AND SIXTY-FIVE CENTS IN THE FINAL SETTLEMENT OF A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN WOMACK CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AND THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR CO., TEXAS.

WHEREAS, by a contract by and between Womack Construction Company and The City of Abilene, Taylor Co., Texas it was agreed to pay said Womack Construction Company the sum of \$ 2.65 per cubic yard for stone rip rap;

And Whereas, Womack Construction Company has asked for an advance of seventy-five cents of the \$ 2.65 per cubic yard according to the original contract price for stone rip rap; and whereas, the said Womack Construction has taken this matter of advancement to the City Engineer of The City of Abilene and said City Engineer has recommended the advancement of seventy-five cents of the \$ 2.65;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, that the Womack Construction Company be advanced the sum of seventy-five cents per cubic yard of the original contract price of \$ 2.65 per cubic yard for stone rip rap used in the construction of the dam on Cedar Creek and now generally known as the dam for Lake Kirby.
