Resolution Accepting The Bid of The American Cast Iron Pipe Company
for Pipe on The Cedar Creek Project and Authorizing The Mayor to
Sign The Plans, Specifications, and Contract for said Pipe and Installation

Whereas, The City of Abilene, Texas advertised for bids for pipe and the installation thereof on the Cedar Creek Project consisting of approximately 22,538 feet from the reservoir to the City Mains and being a distance of a little over one mile;

And whereas, the American Cast Iron Pipe Company submitted a bid which was duly considered along with a number of other bids from sundry companies and contractors for wood and cast iron pipe;

And whereas, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners, after due consideration, decided that the bid of the American Cast Iron Pipe Company would be most advantageous and feasible for The City of Abilene at this time;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Texas that the Mayor be authorized to sign the plans, specifications, and a contract in accordance with said bid and offer of the American Cast Iron Pipe Company and that said bid and offer for said construction work be and the same is accepted.
