RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY CLOSING AN ALLEY RUNNING THROUGH THE BLOCK BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY SIMMONS AVENUE, ON THE NORTH BY SANDEFER STREET, ON THE WEST BY BEECH STREET, AND ON THE SOUTH BY AMBLER AVENUE IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Rupert N. Richardson presented a petition signed by all adjoining property owners along the alley running through a certain block in the City of Abilene, Texas bounded on the east by Simmons Avenue, on the north by Sandefer Street, on the west by Beech Street, and on the south by Ambler Avenue, said property owners requesting that said alley be temporarily closed subject to the terms and conditions stated in said petition and with the understanding that limitations shall not run against any right, title, or interest of The City of Abilene to again open said alley;

And whereas, a plat showing the location of said alley was presented to the Board of Commissioners along with the petition to close said alley as hereinabove set forth, both the plat and the petition being herewith attached and made a part hereof:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved By The Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Texas that the alley as above described be and the same is hereby closed subject to the terms and conditions expressed in the petition filed herewith asking that same be closed and with the express understanding that limitations shall not run against the City in its right to again open said alley at any time its governing body shall see fit.
