

RESOLUTION ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS ON THE 4th DAY OF APRIL, 1933, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR, FOUR COMMISSIONERS, A CHIEF OF POLICE, AND SEVEN SCHOOL TRUSTEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE:

That a general city election shall be held in The City of Abilene, Texas on the first Tuesday in April 1933, the same being the 4th day of April, 1933, at which election there shall be elected for The City of Abilene, Texas, by the persons residing within the boundaries thereof who are qualified voters a Mayor, four Commissioners, a Chief of Police, and Seven School Trustees.

SECTION TWO:

That said election shall be held in the following named places in The City of Abilene, Texas, and the following named persons are appointed as managers and officers for said election at the respective boxes named for the same, to wit:

All persons residing within The City of Abilene, Texas and north of the Texas and Pacific Railway ~~right-of-way~~ Company's main line, and east of Hickory Street, desiring to vote in said election, shall cast their vote in the City Hall, which is hereby designated as election precinct No. 1.

All persons residing in said City, and north of the Texas and Pacific Railway Company's main line, and west of Hickory Street, desiring to vote in said election, shall cast their vote at Gowan Motors, Inc., in the building numbered 1390 North First Street, which is designated as voting precinct No. 2.

All persons residing in said City, and south of the Texas and Pacific Railway Company's main line, and west of Sycamore Street, desiring to vote in said election, shall cast their vote in the Fire Station located at South Fifth and Butternut Street, which is designated as voting precinct No. 3.

All persons residing in said City, and south of the Texas and Pacific Railway Company's main line, and east of Sycamore Street, desiring to vote in said election, shall cast their vote in the Taylor County Courthouse located on Oak Street, which is hereby designated as voting precinct No. 4.

SECTION THREE:

Only qualified voters residing in said City of Abilene shall be entitled to vote in said election, and the manner of holding and conducting said election shall be as provided by the general laws of this state relating to elections.

SECTION FOUR:

The officers holding said election shall make due return thereof to the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Texas on the day following the said election.

SECTION FIVE:

A copy of this resolution shall be published in some newspaper of general circulation in The City of Abilene, Texas, not less than three times, the first publication of which shall appear not less than thirty days prior to the date set for said election, which shall serve as notice for the same.

SECTION SIX:

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
