

RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULT OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, ON THE 4th DAY OF APRIL 1933.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Whereas, on this date came on to be considered by the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Texas the returns of an election held in The City of Abilene, Texas on the 4th day of April 1933, same being the first Tuesday in said month, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, four commissioners, and seven school trustees; and


