

Approving Delinquent Tax Roll and

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRACTICE OF R.M. BARNES IN HOLDING OF CHECKS FOR PAYMENT OF CITY TAXES A REASONABLE TIME, APPROVING COLLECTIONS SHOWN ON TAX COLLECTOR'S RECORD OF CASH RECEIVED DURING JULY, AUGUST, AND SEPTEMBER 1932 AND JANUARY, FEBRUARY, AND MARCH 1933 ON WHICH PENALTIES, INTEREST, AND COSTS WERE NOT REPORTED, ALSO APPROVING THE COLLECTOR'S MANNER OF HANDLING CHECKS RETURNED BECAUSE OF NON-PAYMENT IN PROCURING THE RETURN OF TAX RECEIPTS ISSUED THEREON, AND REFERRING THE MATTER OF TAX ROLLS TO MAKE PROPER SHOWING THAT TAXES REPRESENTED BY ANY AND ALL SUCH CHECKS RETURNED HAVE NOT BEEN PAID TO THE NEWLY ELECTED AND QUALIFIED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, R.M. Barnes, Tax Collector, has received and held checks given for the payment of taxes until after the date when penalties and interest would attach unless taxes were paid; and

WHEREAS, most of such checks have been paid and The City of Abilene has received the taxes as shown in the face of such checks; and

WHEREAS, some questions have been raised by the auditor employed to audit the books with reference to the Tax Collector's Record of cash received during July, August, and September 1932 and January, February, and March 1933 on which penalties, interest, and costs were not reported by the Collector; and *whereas the delinquent tax roll was presented for approval*

WHEREAS, some checks received for the payment of taxes on which tax receipts were issued were not paid, but returned, and the tax receipts so issued were also returned and this proceeding showing conclusively that the said taxes were never paid; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the Tax Collector's handling of the aforementioned matters be and the same are hereby approved, and that the matter of showing that taxes for which receipts were issued and returned showing that taxes were not paid be left to the newly elected and qualified city officials to make such showing of the facts as they see fit.
