

A RESOLUTION OFFERING TO THE TAX PAYERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS THREE ALTERNATIVE PLANS FOR PAYMENT OF 1933 TAXES AND DIRECTING THE ASSESSOR AND COLLECTOR OF TAXES TO WAIVE ALL PENALTIES AND INTEREST ON ALL DELINQUENT TAXES PAID ON OR BEFORE DEC. 1, 1933. *****

WHEREAS, there is an emergency which requires all due consideration to tax payers in the payment of their taxes; and

WHEREAS, it appears advisable that tax payers be offered three alternatives in the payment of their taxes to The City of Abilene, Texas; and

WHEREAS, it seems that penalties and interest on delinquent taxes paid on or before Dec. 1, 1933 should be waived; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF

ABILENE:

That tax payers may have either one of three ways to pay their 1933 taxes, to wit:

1. They may split the payment of such taxes for 1933 and pay half on or before Dec. 1, 1933, and the balance on or before June 1, 1934.
2. They may pay in five installments, the first to be paid prior to Dec. 1, 1933, and the others on the first of January, February, March, and April 1934.
3. They may follow the old plan set forth in the Charter and the rule of general law prior to recent legislative enactments whereby the whole of the taxes due may be paid on or before Jan. 31, 1934.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That all penalties and interest on all delinquent taxes paid on or before Dec. 1, 1933 be and the same are hereby waived.
