

A RESOLUTION LOWERING THE ASSESSED VALUATIONS OF CERTAIN PRO PERTY
ASSESSED AGAINST ALEXANDER TRUST ESTATE.

WHEREAS, Alexander Trust Estate petitioned the Board of
Equalization of The City of Abilene, Texas for a lowering
of valuations on certain pro perty assessed against said estate; and

WHEREAS, after said Board of Equalization refused to lower
said valuations as requested in the petition, exception thereto
was taken and an appeal made to the Board of Commissioners of
The City of Abilene, Texas; and

W WHEREAS, after due consideration of the said petition which
is attached hereto and made part hereof, the Board of Commissioners
aforesaid were of the opinion that certain valuations should be lowered;
therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the West Half Lot A, Block A, Outlot 1, I & G.N. Ry., Abilene,
Texas assessed at \$ 3,200.00 be lowered to a valuation of \$ 2,500.00;
that the fixtures in the Abilene State Bank Building assessed at
\$ 1,250.00 be lowered to \$ 1,000.00; (and that ^{Approximately 3 A. out of} ~~Lot 2, Block 8, Outlot~~ ^{Block 24}
~~Outlot One, East 2/3,~~ ^{20,250.40} ~~be lowered to \$ 14,000.00~~) be lowered to \$ 12,500.00
Be it further resolved that the other values as outlined in the petition
as the final valuation by the Board of Equalization be and the same
are hereby in all things approved.
