

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSOR AND COLLECTOR OF TAXES FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS TO CHANGE HIS RECORDS WHICH SHOW A CERTAIN PIECE OF PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE BODY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO BE TAXED AT A VALUATION OF OVER 95% OF ITS ACTUAL VALUE WHEN IT IS THE RULE THAT PROPERTY BE TAXED AT 80% OF ITS VALUE, THE PARTICULAR CASE SHOWING ON ITS FACE TO BE A MISTAKE.

WHEREAS, it is the rule and practice of the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene, Texas at present and has been the rule and practice for many years past that property within the City should be taxed at a valuation of 80% of its actual value; and

WHEREAS, the following described property shows to have been set up on the records of The City of Abilene to be taxed at a valuation of over 95% of its actual value, said property being described as follows: *5-5N-6-6a-7-7a- Blk 8 Col Drive*

WHEREAS, it appears that the records thus show error on their face and that the same should be corrected; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, that the Assessor and Collector be and he is hereby authorized and directed to correct the mistake thus shown and that the property described be set up on the records as taxed at the rate of 60% of its actual value in keeping with all other property taxed and subject to taxation within the corporate limits of said City.
