

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING \$ 375.00 TENDERED BY THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY AS COMPLETE SETTLEMENT FOR DAMAGES DONE TO THE ROLLER BY A TRAIN WHILE SAID ROLLER WAS USED IN MAKING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ON RAILROAD CROSSINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, a roller used in making improvements of railroad crossings in The City of Abilene, Texas, same being the property of said City was run over and badly damaged by a train operated by the Texas and Pacific Railway Company; and

WHEREAS, said company has offered \$ 375.00 as a complete settlement with the understanding that the City keep said roller; therefore,

That said \$ 375.00 be accepted as a complete release for any and all damages suffered by the said City and that the said City keep the said roller.
