

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED TO MRS. BETTIE CLARK, A WIDOW, TO THE EAST ONE-HALF OF LOTS NOS. 7 AND 8, BLOCK NO ONE HUNDRED SIXTY, SITUATED IN ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, a suit was filed by the City of Abilene to foreclose for delinquent taxes on the hereinafter described land, in the year 1895, and

whereas, a judgment was entered foreclosing the tax lien on said property, and the taxes paid the city by the then owner and the property conveyed to various and sundry persons since that date without any formal release of said judgment, and

whereas, it appears that all delinquent taxes against such property save and except the year 1935 have been fully paid, and they are to be paid out of a loan that is now being made on the said property, and


whereas, it appears to be to the best interests of the City of Abilene that said property be quit claimed to the now owner of same, therefore:


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute a quit claim deed to Mrs. Bettie Clark, on the following described property, to-wit:

East one-half of Lots Nos. Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block No. One Hundred Sixty (160), situated in the City of Abilene, Taylor county, Texas.
