

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBDIVISION AND CONTINUATION OF THE I.O.O.F. CEMETERY TO INCLUDE BLOCKS 51 TO 56, AND THE SUBDIVISION AND CONTINUATION OF THE MASONIC CEMETERY TO INCLUDE BLOCK 42.

WHEREAS, public convenience and necessity and the best interests of the City of Abilene demands that the said City have at its disposal additional burial space, and

WHEREAS, the Masonic Cemetery and the I.O.O.F. Cemetery are subject to being further subdivided and continued without interference with vested rights of the owners of lots in said Cemeteries, and

Whereas, the City Engineer has subdivided and continued said Cemeteries as shown on a plat on file in the office of the City Secretary, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE :

That the subdivision and continuation of the I. O. O. F Cemetery to include Blocks 51 to 56, inclusive, and the subdivision and continuation of the Masonic Cemetery to include Block 42, be and the same are hereby approved, and the prices of each lot in each of said Blocks ~~are~~ hereby fixed at \$600.00 <sup>respectively</sup> and \$100.00, until further official action by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, changing said price. The plat showing said subdivision and continuation, on file in the office of the City Secretary, and styled "Map of the City of Abilene, Texas, Continuation of the I.O.O.F. Cemetery to include Blocks 51 to 56 and of the Masonic Cemetery to include Block 42. By O. K. Hobbs City Eng. May 7th. 1934," is hereby made a part of this resolution as much as if incorporated into the body hereof.
