

RESOLUTION SEGREGATING, DISCONTINUING AND EX-
CLUDING A TRACT OF LAND FROM THE CITY LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS THE hereinafter described unoccupied land lies
within the city limits of the City of Abilene, and lies along
and contiguous to the city limits, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the City of Abilene
and of the public generally that said land be segregated, dis-
continued and excluded from the city limits of the City of
Abilene, by reason of the fact that a road is being built across
said land, which same will be maintained by the county,
Now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
CITY OF ABILENE :

That the following described land heretofore lying within
the city limits of the City of Abilene, be and is hereby
segregated, discontinued and excluded from the city limits of
the said City of Abilene:

"Beginning at the S. W. Cor. of lot 17, Blk. I Cockrell
and Gray's Subdivision of lots 2, 3 and Pt. of 4 of Block
209 of the Original City of Abilene, Texas; Thence north
140'; Thence west to the west boundary line of Cherry street;
Thence south 140'; Thence east to the place of beginning, 20"
save and except a 5' strip of land over the Cherry Street, 20"
water supply main, said 5' strip being a continuation of the
strip connecting the City Water Purification Plant No. 2
properties with the rest of the City of Abilene "
