

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PART OF SECTION I OF ACTS
1924, 42RD. LEGISLATURE, 4TH. CALLED SESSION, H. B.
#6, PROVIDING FOR PROGRESSIVE PENALTY ON DELINQUENT
TAXES, AND FIXING INTEREST ON DELINQUENT TAXES AT
6%, FOR 1924 TAXES ONLY.

Whereas it appears to be to the best interest of the City
of Abilene and its inhabitants to adopt portions of the
state law governing penalty and interest on delinquent taxes,
and

Whereas the state law controlling same as passed by the 42rd.
legislature and known as section one of H. B. # 6, cannot
be fully adopted by ordinance and made a permanent part of
the tax laws of the City of Abilene for the reason that a
resolution was passed September 21st. 1924 which conflicts
with a part of said state law, and which has already been
acted upon and taken advantage of by some of the tax payers
of the City of Abilene, and

Whereas such state law may be fully adopted by ordinance
at a later date to affect all delinquent taxes for 1925 and
thereafter, Now therefore :

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
ABILENE :

Section I :

That if any person firm or corporation has not acted upon,
complied with and taken advantage of any one of the three
alternative plans of payment of 1924 taxes set forth in a
resolution passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City
of Abilene on Spetember 21st. 1924, recorded in Volume 1
page of the minutes of the City of abilene, then the
following penalty shall be payable on such 1924 taxes: If paid
during the month of February¹⁹²⁵ one per cent (1%); if paid during
the month of March,¹⁹²⁵ two per cent (2%); if paid during the month
of April,¹⁹²⁵ three per cent (3%); if paid during the month of
May,¹⁹²⁵ four per cent (4%); if paid during the month of June,¹⁹²⁵ five
per cent (5%), and if paid on or after July 1st. 1925, eight per
cent (8%).

Section 2: No interest shall be charged on said 1924 taxes
if paid ~~entirely~~ before July 1st. 1925. All 1924 taxes remaining
unpaid on July 1st. 1925 shall bear interest at the rate of
6% per annum from said date last mentioned.

Section 3: The Assessor and Collector of taxes of the City
of Abilene with the advise and assistance of a competent
auditor shall devise and put into use such forms as may be
necessary, if any, additional forms are needed, to be used by
said Assessor and Collector for noting thereon the payment of
taxes in accordance with the provisions of this resolution.
