RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN THE AMOUNT OF  
PENALTY AND INTEREST TO BE COLLECTED ON  
DELINQUENT TAXES DUE THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, certain acts of the legislature dealing with the subject of delinquent taxes and the amount of penalty and interest to be paid thereon, have been subject to two conflicting constructions and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has heretofore passed a resolution to carry out the policy established by the state with reference to penalty and interest on delinquent taxes and,

WHEREAS, said resolutions are subject to the same conflicting construction with reference to the amount of penalty and interest to be paid and,

WHEREAS, the attorney general of the State of Texas, has heretofore has issued an opinion setting forth one construction of said laws and has, since the issuance of said opinion, issued a new opinion reversing the first one and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be to the best interest of the City of Abilene to conform to the policy of the state and county as set forth in the last ruling of the attorney general with reference to the amount of penalty and interest to be collected on delinquent taxes due the City of Abilene,  
NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE  
CITY OF ABILENE:

That interest on all taxes delinquent as of August 1, 1934, and paid after June 30, 1935, will be figured from July 1, 1935 at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, and that a penalty of eight per cent (8%) will be added thereto on such taxes paid after June 30, 1935.
