

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSOR AND COLLECTOR
OF TAXES TO CORRECT RECORDS AND TO GIVE CREDIT
TO MRS. J. C. BURKETT FOR OVER-PAYMENT OF TAXES
FOR THE YEARS 1921 AND 1922.

W H E R E A S, it appears that by reason of a mistake
in addition made in the Ehrenborg tax survey of the City of Abilene,
by adding \$2,805 and \$150 and getting the erroneous total of
\$4,205, instead of the correct total of \$2,955, Mrs. J. C. Burkett
was over-charged the sum of \$20.16 for the year 1921, and \$14.49
for the year 1922, on lots one and two, block 19, of the Highland
Addition to the City of Abilene; and

W H E R E A S, it appears to be to the best interests
of the City of Abilene that the said mistake be corrected and the
records be adjusted, and that Mrs. J. C. Burkett receive a credit
of \$34.65 on her taxes for 1923. Now, t h e r e f o r e,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,
That the Assessor and Collector of Taxes be and he is
hereby authorized and directed to correct the error above set out
on his records, and to credit the said Mrs. J. C. Burkett with the
sum of \$34.65 on lots one and two of block 19, of the Highland
Addition to the City of Abilene, for the year 1923.
