

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO PETITION THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE FOR ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY:

Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Abilene Christian College that W. H. Free as the president of said Board be and he is hereby authorized and requested to join M. E. Mullings in a petition addressed to the Board of Commissioners of The City of Abilene requesting the annexation of the following described property to said city, same being described as follows:

Situated in Taylor County, Texas, being a part of Section 34, Blind Asylum Lands, and a part of Block 17 of the Continuation of Abilene Heights, an addition to The City of Abilene, as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book No. 1, page 598, of the Plat Records of Taylor County, Texas, the property involved herein being described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point in the present city limits of The City of Abilene on the south line of Cedar Crest Drive, which point is south from the southeast corner of Lot No. 1 of Block 17 of said addition above described; thence in a north-westerly direction along the south boundary line of Cedar Crest Drive to a point where said south boundary line intersects the present city limits; thence east with the present city limits to a point in Avenue D which is an ell corner in the present city limits of The City of Abilene; thence south following the present city limits to the place of beginning.
