

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SHERIFF OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, TO READVVERTISE FOR SALE LOTS NOS. 1 AND 2, ~~CARTER'S~~ ^{and} CARTER'S SUBDIVISION OF LOT NO. 2, BLOCK NO. 178, HERETOFORE BOUGHT BY THE CITY AT TAX FORECLOSURE SALE AGAINST GEO. T. HEROD, JR.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene on the 31st day of August, 1938, filed suit in the 104th District Court of Taylor County, Texas, against Geo. T. Herod, Jr., ^{and} Lake L. Herod, surviving widow of Geo. T. Herod, deceased for foreclosure of tax liens on Lots Nos. 1 and 2, Block 4, Carter's Subdivision of Lot 2, Block 178 of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, said cause being No. 51658 pending on the docket of said court and Taylor County, the State of Texas and Taylor-Callahan County's Road District No. 7 the other taxing units were made parties to said suit and duly intervened therein; and on December 10, 1938, judgment was rendered in favor of the plaintiff and said other taxing units foreclosing the tax liens on said property; and on May 27, 1939, an order of sale was issued on said judgment directing the sheriff to sell the same at public sale as provided by law; and on July 4, 1939, said property was sold by said sheriff to the City of Abilene for the amount of taxes owing thereon, to wit, \$583.35 and court costs and said sheriff by his deed duly conveyed said property to the said City of Abilene to be held in trust for the benefit of itself and the other taxing units for the period prescribed by law; and whereas, the owner of said property has failed to redeem the same and more than six months has expired after the two year redemption period and the City of Abilene desires said property sold and the proceeds of sale to be applied on the taxes on said property as is provided in Article 7345b, Section 9; therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE: That the Sheriff of Taylor County, Texas, be and he is hereby requested to readvertise, and sell said property at public sale, as prescribed in said Section 9 of said article 7345b.
