

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:
That the Mayor of said City be authorized and directed to execute

S. Higginbotham for the sum of \$58.88, in the 42nd District Court of

the said City of Abilene in Taylor County, Texas, has released and
does by these presents release the said F. S. Higginbotham from all
liability on account of said judgment and declares the same satisfied
in full.
