

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BOY SCOUTS TO USE WATER
FROM WELL BELOW DAM AT LAKE ABILENE.

Whereas, the Chisholm Trail Council of the Boy Scouts of America have established camp sites in the State Park below the dam of Lake Abilene and have constructed a swimming pool at Camp Tonkawa about one-half mile below said dam and situated about 2300 feet from the well belonging to said City used as a part of its water system and aid Boy Scouts have asked permission to use water from said well for said swimming pool and some twelve camp sites of said organization;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That said Council of said Boy Scouts, be and they are hereby authorized to use water from said well for the purpose as aforesaid without charge from said City, said boy scouts to furnish their own pumps, pipes and appliances and their own filtration or purification plant; and in no event is said city to be liable for failure of supply of said water, if any; or the failure to filter or purify said water which is furnished gratis to said organization; and said water from said well may be used by said City to exhaustion, if deemed necessary by the Board of Commissioners or Governing Body of said City which may also revoke said permit for any reason which it deems necessary.
