

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BOUNDARY LINES
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, CORRECTED TO THE
28TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1946.

WHEREAS, certain amendments to the charter of the City of Abilene were adopted by a majority of the qualified voters voting at an election held on the 27th day of August, 1946 and it is necessary to have the boundaries of said city adjusted and corrected to August 28, 1946; THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following metes and bounds of the boundaries of said city on August 28, 1946, which boundary lines were prepared by James Allen, Assistant City Engineer of said city, hereto attached and made a part hereof are hereby adopted as the correct boundaries of the said City of Abilene as they existed on August 28, 1946 and the City Secretary is hereby directed to file a copy of this resolution as a part of the records of said city.
