

RESOLUTION ORDERING THE CLOSING OF AN ALLEY
RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH ACROSS BLOCK 34, ORIGINAL
CITY OF ABILENE, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
EXECUTE QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO ADJUTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

WHEREAS, the official plat of the City of Abilene recorded
in the office of the County Clerk, Taylor County, Texas, shows an
alley running north and south across Block 34, Original City of
Abilene, and,

WHEREAS, said alley has never been opened for public use
and it appears that no rights have accrued to the public re-
garding the use of same, and,

WHEREAS, Texas Mill and Elevator Company is the owner and
owner in fee simple of Lots three (3) to ten (10), inclusive, of
said Block 34, and,

WHEREAS, Abilene and Southern Railway Company is the owner in
fee simple of Lots One (1) two (2), eleven (11) and twelve (12) of
said Block 34.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

1. That the above described alley be and the same is hereby
closed and abandoned by the City of Abilene.
2. That the Mayor be and is hereby ordered to execute a
Quit-claim deed to Texas Mill and Elevator Company and Abilene
and Southern Railway Co pany, quitclaiming all interest in and
to said alley abutting the property owned by each respective owner.
