


ORDER APPOINTING TEMPORARY CORPORATION JUDGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, I, Ernest Grissom, Mayor of the City of Abilene, Texas, pursuant to Section 51 of the Charter of said City, have this day and do by these presents appoint Wilson Johnston, a qualified voter of the City of Abilene, a licensed and practicing attorney, and one who has resided in said City at least two years before this date, to serve as temporary Judge of the Corporation Court of the City of Abilene during the temporary absence of Judge A. K. Doss, the present Judge of the Corporation Court. This appointment is effective from the date hereof, subject to confirmation by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene as provided by Section 50 of the Charter.
