RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE
PIPE LINE LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE
TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Mayor, C.E. Gatlin be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Abilene a certain Pipe Line Agreement, dated May 8, 1953 by and between the Texas and Pacific Railway Company, Licensor, and The City of Abilene, Texas, licensee, providing for the installation and maintenance of ^{Sanitary} 12 inch/sewer line across and under the tracks and right of way of Licensor, located at Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, said location being more particularly described as follows:

Line begins at west end of existing 12" sewer line covered by Railway's Lease No.15265, said point being 70-ft. southerly from center line of Railway's main line track opposite V.C.S. 21518427; Thence westerly along Railway's right ofway to a point 56-ft. southerly from center line of aforesaid main line and opposite V.C.S. 21522483.6; Thence continuing westerly to a point 58.5-ft. southerly from center line of said main line and opposite V.C.S. 21524439.1; Thence continuing westerly approximately 200-ft. to a point 60 ft. southerly from center line of said main line; Thence continuing westerly to a manhole 50-ft. southerly from center line of said main line opposite V.C.S. 21527457.5; Thence northerly crossing under said main line at V.C.S.21527457.5, and continuing northerly to point in Railway's north property line, where said sewer line leaves Railway's property;
