

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE ADMONISHING ALL
OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO MAKE PAYMENT
OF DELINQUENT AD VALOREM TAXES DUE THE
CITY OF ABILENE AND/OR ABILENE INDEPENDENT
SCHOOL DISTRICT ON MOTOR VEHICLES TO AVOID
COURT ACTION FOR COLLECTION OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene is whole heartily in accord with the intensified efforts of the City Tax Assessor and Collector to effect payment of delinquent taxes on motor vehicles, and

WHEREAS, all personal property not specifically exempt by State statute is subject to taxation, and

WHEREAS, motor vehicles are not so exempt and assessment is made by the City Tax Assessor and Collector and placed on the City Tax Rolls according to the instruction of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the taxpayers of the City of Abilene and Abilene Independent School District make payment of ad valorem taxes on motor vehicles as due, and


WHEREAS, it is the duty of every property owner to make payment of all taxes without demand thereof from the City Tax Assessor and Collector,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene in regular session assembled, go on record to admonish residents of the City of Abilene and Abilene Independent School District to make payment of all delinquent taxes due the City of Abilene and Abilene Independent School District, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager instruct the City Tax Assessor and Collector to continue with intensified efforts of the Tax Department toward collection of delinquent taxes to the extent of filing suits on unpaid accounts in fairness to the majority of the citizens of Abilene who consistently make payment of taxes as due.
