

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND
CITY SECRETARY TO EXECUTE RELEASE OF
TAX JUDGMENTS UPON PAYMENT OF THE SAME

WHEREAS, IT HAS come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas, that there are many tax judgments existing in favor of the City of Abilene against individuals, corporations and firms for the payment of delinquent taxes, and

WHEREAS, it is oftimes necessary and advisable that the same be released in order to expedite the payment of same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the mayor and the city secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute releases upon any tax judgment existing in favor of the city of Abilene upon the payment of the full amount of said judgment due and owing to the City of Abilene, and to attach the seal of the municipal corporation thereto.

SECTION 2: That all such releases shall be executed after the payment of the money and the amount thereof has been confirmed by the tax assessor-collector and the form of the release has been properly approved by the city attorney.

SECTION 3: That no other and further action of this Board shall be necessary prior to the execution and delivery of such releases.
