A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE CERTAIN CONTRACTS WITH THE TEXAS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, under the Federal Interstate Highway program, the City of Abilene is required to move certain utility lines; and,

WHEREAS, under the present policies and procedures of the Texas Highway Department, it is necessary for the City of Abilene, Texas, to enter into a contract concerning the moving of said lines in order to be reimbursed as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the City of Abilene, Texas, to enter into and execute such contracts and to authorize and allow the City Manager to sign such contract as the official representative of the City of Abilene, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That the City Manager of the City of Abilene, Texas, be and is hereby authorized to enter into and execute, as the official representative of the City of Abilene, Texas, such utility replacement and utility moving contracts as are made necessary by the location of Interstate Highway number 20, and other State Highways.
