RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN ACCEPTANCE OF AN AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, TO EXTEND THE LEASE AGREEMENT FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS, FROM APRIL 30, 1961, TO APRIL 30, 1966, ON THE PARKING AREA LEASED FROM THE RAILROAD AT NORTH FIRST AND CEDAR STREETS, AT THE SAME RENTAL OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) FOR THE FIVE (5) YEAR PERIOD UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS SET OUT IN THE ORIGINAL LEASE OF APRIL 30, 1956.

WHEREAS, on April 30, 1956, the City of Abilene leased for a five (5) year period a small tract of land located at North First and Cedar Streets from Texas and Pacific Railway Company for the purpose of parking. WHEREAS, the City still needs such land for parking purposes and Texas and Pacific Railway Company has offered to extend the term of said lease for another five (5) years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE.

SECTION I: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the offer made by the Texas and Pacific Railway Company to extend the term of lease for another five (5) years from April 30, 1961, to April 30, 1966, on the tract of land located at North First and Cedar Streets in Abilene, Texas, the same being that tract of 2,445 square feet more or less which was leased by the City from the Railroad on April 30, 1956.

That said lease shall be extended under the same terms and conditions as the original lease.
