

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS TO INSTALL INTERSECTIONAL LIGHTING AT CERTAIN POINTS OF ACCESS AND EGRESS ALONG WINTERS FREEWAY.

WHEREAS, it is a matter of public safety that there be adequate lighting of intersections and directional signs on freeways and major thoroughfares; and,

WHEREAS, U. S. Highway 83 By-Pass, which passes through and around the City of Abilene, has been completed and opened to public use; and,

WHEREAS, said Freeway and Highway is not equipped with "decision point" lighting at points of access or egress to said freeway, nor is there lighting of directional signs; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Highway Commission of the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, requested to give favorable and prompt consideration to the installation and construction of adequate lighting of directional signs and points of access and egress to U. S. Highway 83 By-Pass (Winters Freeway) as said freeway passes through the Abilene community.

Section 2: That the Board of Commissioners hereby expresses a willingness to cooperate and participate with other governmental jurisdictions to the extent necessary to secure the installation of adequate lighting of freeway intersections in the general vicinity of Abilene and further its willingness to assume the costs of electrical services and maintenance of any lighting installations made pursuant to this request.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption.
