

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TEXAS, COMMENDING ROBERT M. TINSTMAN FOR HIS SERVICES AS THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ABILENE.
