

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPOINTING DON R. WILSON ASSISTANT CORPORATION COURT JUDGE TO ACT IN THE ABSENCE OR UNAVAILABILITY OF THE JUDGE OF THE CORPORATION COURT.

WHEREAS, there are occasions when the Judge of the Corporation Court is temporarily unable to serve and Section 77 of the Charter of the City of Abilene provides for the appointment of Assistant Corporation Court Judges when those occasions arise, and the Judge of the Corporation Court has recommended that Don R. Wilson, his predecessor, be appointed Assistant Corporation Court Judge to act in his absence; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Don R. Wilson be, and is hereby, appointed Assistant Corporation Court Judge to serve at such times as the Judge of the Corporation Court may request.

Section 2: That the service of the said Don R. Wilson as Judge of the Corporation Court for hearing juvenile cases on Thursday, February 6, 1964, be, and the same is hereby in all things ratified and approved.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
