A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE ASSIGNMENT OF CERTAIN MECHANIC'S LIEN CONTRACTS AND NOTES FROM HAYTER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID ASSIGNMENT OF LIENS, AND THE CITY SECRETARY TO FILE SAID ASSIGNMENT OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Hayter Construction Company has contracted with the owners of the hereinafter described real property to pave the street adjacent to said property in accordance with City of Abilene specifications, said street being Elm Street from South 14th Street to Belmont Boulevard, in the City of Abilene, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, each owner of said real property has executed a mechanic's lien contract and note to said Hayter Construction Company, to secure the payment for said paving work; and,

WHEREAS, Hayter Construction Company desires to assign said mechanic's lien contracts and notes to the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Mayor be, and is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Abilene, the assignment of the following described mechanic's lien contracts and notes:
