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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE BID OF E. M. BAILEY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,900.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK IN NELSON PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR SAID WORK.

Section 3: That the Chief Accountant be and is hereby authorized to make payment in the above amount to said Contractor from the 1964 Parks Bond Funds.

Section 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
