Section 1: That the total bid of Hawkins & Westbrook, Inc., in the total amount of up to Three Hundred Ten Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars (\$310,800.00) be and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted, and a contract for such construction work is hereby awarded to said firm.

Section 2: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute such contract on behalf of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
