A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE COMPACTION BODY AND TWO HUNDRED EIGHT (208) CONTAINERS FOR THE USE OF THE REFUSE DISPOSAL DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASING AGENT TO EXTEND THE PURCHASE ORDER AT THE SAME BID PRICES, NOT TO EXCEED 25% OF THE TOTAL BID PRICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has duly advertised and given such notice as required by law for bids on the purchase of one compaction body and 208 containers for the use of the Refuse Disposal Department; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on June 22, 1965, as follows:

Scott-Holman Company, Inc.	65,720.00; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Sid Patterson is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) compaction body; one hundred forty (140) 3-cubic yard containers; fifty-six (56) 4-cubic yard containers; one (1) 6-cubic yard container; and eleven (11) eight cubic yard containers from Sid Patterson Company, Inc., for a total bid price of Sixty-four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$64,761.00), payable in installments with 4% simple interest on the unpaid balance.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby further authorized to purchase additional containers at the unit bid price specified, in such quantities deemed necessary over the next six (6) months' period, said extension not to exceed 25% of the original bid price of \$64,761.00.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
