A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE ABILENE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY AND HAWKINS & WESTBROOK, CONTRACTORS, PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF AN OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ABILENE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY, INC.

WHEREAS, the operating agreement between the City of Abilene and the Abilene Zoological Society, Inc., grants to such Society the right to make permanent improvements to the Abilene zoo provided the approval of the Parks and Recreation Board and of the City Council is first obtained in writing; and,

WHEREAS, such society has, heretofore on the 2nd day of June, 1965, entered into a contract with Hawkins & Westbrook, Contractors, to construct a flamingo shelter, pool area and pool fence at the Abilene zoo; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board has recommended approval of such contract and it is the opinion of the City Council that such contract is in the best interest of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the above described contract, together with the plans and specifications for such construction, the proposed location and the manner of financing such construction, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

Section 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
