A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO C. B. OATES CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RECREATION CENTER IN SEARS PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids on the construction of a recreation building in Sears Park; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on August 10, 1965, as follows:

WHEREAS, it appears that C. B. Oates Construction Company is the lowest responsible bid, and it is the opinion of the City Council that a contract should be awarded in the total amount of Seventy-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Nine Dollars (\$79,809.00); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the bid of C. B. Oates Construction Company, in the amount of \$79,809.00, be and is hereby in all things accepted, and a contract awarded thereto.

Section 2: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute such contract on behalf of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That Architect's fee in the amount of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Nine Dollars (\$4,789.00) be and is hereby in all things approved and ordered paid, in accordance with the terms of said Architect's contract.

Section 4: That an expenditure in the amount of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000 be and is hereby approved for the construction of a paved parking lot adjacent to such recreation building.

Section 5: That funds in the total amount of Ninety-six Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$96,598.00) be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for the payment of the herein specified construction costs.

Section 6: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
