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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWELVE (12) 1966 MODEL VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids on the purchase of twelve (12) 1966 model vehicles for the use of the Police Department; and,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby authorized to purchase twelve (12) 1966 model automobiles from Arrow Ford, said vehicles equipped with factory air conditioners, at a unit price of Two Thousand One Hundred Eighty-nine and 70/100 Dollars (\$2,189.70), for a total bid price of Twenty-six Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-six and 40/100 Dollars (\$26,276.40).

Section 2: That six of the above described automobiles be and are hereby authorized for immediate purchase; the remaining six be and are hereby authorized for purchase within the next four months.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
