A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A DITCHING MACHINE FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has duly advertised and given such notice as required by law for bids on the purchase of a ditching machine; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on November 16, 1965, as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Browning-Ferris Machinery Company is the best responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby authorized to purchase one new ditching machine from Browning-Ferris Machinery Company for a total bid price of Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Seventy-three and 75/100 Dollars (\$16,173.75).

Section 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
