Section 1: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby authorized to purchase the
sprinkler heads, Section I, from TELSCO Industries for a total bid price of Five
Hundred Fifty-nine and 10/100 Dollars (\$559.10).


Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be and is hereby authorized to purchase
