

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE ~~SEVENTY~~ ^{FIFTY} HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED ~~TWENTY~~ ^{FIVE} DOLLARS (~~\$172,812.00~~) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS IN NELSON PARK. (~~\$ 30,852.00~~)

WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the City of Abilene on February 18, 1964, voted in favor of the issuance of bonds for the construction of a new zoo and certain other improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Abilene has recommended the expenditure of \$172, 812. 00 for improvements at Nelson Park; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that such improvements should be made; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That funds in the total amount of \$30, 052. 00 be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for the construction of a concession building (\$18, 690. 00); a restroom building (\$8, 630. 00); and architect's fee (\$2, 732. 00).

Section 2: That funds in the total amount of \$58, 500. 00 be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for the construction of paving in the zoo (\$29, 740. 00); architect's fee (\$2, 974. 00); renovation of Runway "A" (\$32, 000. 00); sidewalk median, strip (\$6, 000. 00); renovation of Runway "B" (\$6, 500. 00); and entrance circle (\$14, 000. 00).

Section 3: That funds in the total amount of \$31, 300. 00 be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for the construction of a sprinkler system for the zoo (\$13, 500. 00); and sprinkler system for the primary park (\$17, 800. 00).

Section 4: That funds in the total amount of \$19, 446. 00 be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for the installation of landscaping in the zoo (\$15, 946. 00) and in the primary park areas (\$3, 500. 00).

Section 5: That funds in the total amount of \$800. 00 be and are hereby appropriated from the 1964 Parks Improvement Bond Funds for split cedar fencing material (\$500. 00) and rock and concrete (\$300. 00).

Section 6: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
