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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CABLES FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

Section 1: That the bid of Graybar Electric Company, for the purchase of cables for traffic signals in the total amount of \$3,795.00 be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase cables for traffic signals from said firm.

Section 3: That funds in the amount of \$3,795.00 be, and are hereby appropriated from the Street Bond Fund for payment thereof.
