A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE PAVING OF STREETS AND PARKING AREAS AT NELSON PARK IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the paving of streets and parking areas at Nelson Park in the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on April 4, 1966, such bids being as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City of Abilene that the bid of Abilene Paving Company in the total amount of Twenty Five Thousand One Hundred Sixty-six & 58/100 Dollars (\$25,166.58) is the lowest responsible bid and should be awarded the contract for the improvements of such streets and parking areas; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:


Section 1: That the bid of Abilene Paving Company for the paving of streets and parking areas at Nelson Park in the City of Abilene, in the total amount of \$25,166.58, be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted and said firm is hereby awarded a contract, to be prepared by the City Attorney, for the construction of such improvements.

Section 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
