A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PAVEMENT OF THE INTERSECTIONS OF BIRCHWOOD STREET AND GRAPE STREET; BIRCHWOOD STREET AND CLINTON STREET; AND BIRCHWOOD STREET AND VICTORIA STREET; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SUCH PAVEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Administrative Staff has recommended that the inter- sections of Birchwood Street and Grape Street; Birchwood Street and Clinton Street; and Birchwood Street and Victoria Street be paved; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Abilene that such paving be accomplished; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Engineering Department be, and is hereby, authorized to prepare plans and specifications for the pavement of Birchwood Street from Grape Street North to the city limits of the City of Abilene, and for the pavement of Impact Drive from the city limits of the City of Abilene to the Old Anson Road.

Section 2: That there shall be, and is hereby, appropriated the sum of \$1,500.00 out of the Street Improvement Bond Funds to pay for the cost of paving the intersections of Birchwood Street and Grape Street, Birchwood Street and Clinton Street; and Birchwood Street and Victoria Street.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
