

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID OF INDUSTRIAL DISPOSAL SUPPLY COMPANY FOR REFUSE CONTAINERS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PROMISSORY NOTE IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE BID IN PAYMENT OF SUCH REFUSE CONTAINERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene did heretofore advertise and give such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of refuse containers; and

WHEREAS, two bids were submitted, to-wit: the bid of Industrial Disposal Supply Company for a total price of \$33,456.00, and the bid of Sid Patterson of Texas for a total price of \$45,900.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the bid of Industrial Disposal Supply Company should be accepted in the public interest, and that a promissory note totaling the full amount of the bid, providing for two annual installment payments toward the payment of such note, commencing October 1, 1968, should be executed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the bid of Industrial Disposal Supply Company for refuse containers, at a total bid price of \$33,456.00, be, and the same is hereby, accepted.

Section 2: That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute a Promissory Note in the full amount of the bid in behalf of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
