A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE MOTOR GRADER MEETING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of One Motor Grader for the use of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on September 19, 1966, said bids being as follows:

Plains Machinery Company	\$ 18,000.00
Allis Chalmers Manufacturing Company	20,598.00
Treanor Equipment Company	23,000.00

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Plains Machinery Company in the total amount of Eighteen Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$18,000.00) is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Section 1: That the bid of Plains Machinery Company for the purchase of One (1) Motor Grader in the total amount of \$18,000.00 be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase such item of equipment from such firm.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
