A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE LADDER MEETING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of One Ladder for the use of the City of Abilene; and,
WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on October 12, 1966, said bids being as follows:

Dave Clarrpitt	\$ 3,996.00
J. H. Holan Corporation	3,193.00

WHEREAS, the bid of J. H. Holan Corporation, which was the low bid, did not meet the specifications of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Dave Clarrpitt in the total amount of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Six and No/100 Dollars (\$3,996.00) is the lowest responsible bid meeting the specifications and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the bid of Dave Clarrpitt for the purchase of One Ladder in the total amount of \$3,996.00 be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase such item of equipment from such firm.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
