A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TEN DRINKING FOUNTAINS MEETING
SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as
required by law for bids for the purchase of Ten Drinking Fountains for the use
of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on November 22, 1966, said bids
being as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Morrison
Supply Company in the total amount of Two Thousand, Forty-Seven and 22/100
Dollars (\$2, 047. 22), is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the bid of Morrison Supply Company for the purchase of Ten (10)
Drinking Fountains in the total amount of \$2, 047. 22 be, and the same is hereby in all
things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase
such items from such firm.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its
passage.
