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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 8,000 CUBIC YARDS CRUSHED AGGREGATE BASE MATERIAL AND 5,000 CUBIC YARDS ROCK SCREENINGS OR SAND MATERIAL MEETING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of 8,000 Cubic Yards Crushed Aggregate Base Material and 5,000 Cubic Yards Rock Screenings or Sand Material for the use of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on December 19, 1966, said bids being as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of J. H. Strain and Sons in the total amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:  
Section 1: That the bid of J. H. Strain and Sons for the sale of 8,000 Cubic Yards Crushed Aggregate Base Material and 5,000 Cubic Yards Rock Screenings or Sand Material to the City of Abilene in the total amount of \$5,000.00 be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase said materials from such firm.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
